

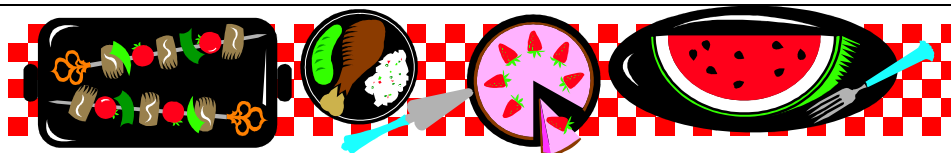

Missionaries to Scotland

What an exciting time in our lives! We have begun the process of looking for a house to move to Arbroath and begin our own work. After much prayer and consideration, we have decided that Arbroath is where the Lord wants us. I know that in our last prayer letter we said to pray for us as we began to move towards Scone. Well, the building that we were looking at in Scone would be great for church services, however, it is not available for Sunday mornings. We could meet just about any other time during the week or even on Sunday nights, but we would never be able to hold a Sunday morning church service because the Quakers are already renting the building for Sunday morning services. After counseling with my pastor, we have decided to pursue starting a work in Arbroath. Please pray that we will be able to find a house as soon as possible. Our lease is up in July, but we have already gotten permission from our landlord to move as soon as we find a house. In addition, the radio ministry opportunity that I spoke about a couple of months ago is still available in Arbroath and will be a great way to preach the Gospel, especially since it is free! We really covet your prayers over the next two months as we begin to take what will be one of our biggest steps of faith in the ministry, starting our own work.

Since we have been here in Jedburgh, we have seen five people come to know Christ as their personal Saviour! We have learned a lot from the national pastor here and look forward to taking what we have learned and using it in our ministry in Arbroath. We have gotten to know the people here and we are saddened that we are moving, but we know that we must follow the Lord as He leads us.

On a personal note, my driving test is almost here. I have been taking driving lessons over the past two months, and I will take my driving test on May 22. Please pray that all goes well. Here in the UK, 50% of all people who take the driving test fail. If I fail my test, I will have to wait another eight weeks to reschedule. By that time, we will have moved to Arbroath and I would probably have to take a couple of more lessons just to get used to the course.

Our family seems to be doing well and the weather has been warming up. It was almost 60 degrees Fahrenheit the other day! When it gets that warm, they say "It's boiling!" They have no idea, do they? Our kids enjoy playing outside (when it is not raining) and getting to meet new kids at the park. One of the reasons why we want to move as soon as possible is because we want to get things rolling with our ministry while the weather is nice and people are outside. As always, continue to pray for us as we labor for the Lord.
