We completed the 6,500 square foot church building in Maine. The building consisted of an Auditorium, Offices, Bathrooms, Baptistry and Changing Rooms, Prayer Room, Foyer, Kitchen, Fellowship Hall and Nursery. The members finished up painting the walls, installed rubber base cove in some of the rooms and cleaned. The paving contractor waited until we moved our three trailers and trucks off the property before he could lay the parking lot and driveway. They hosted a GIBF regional meeting November 5th - 6th and their Missions Conference November 7th - 8th. They made arrangements to fly me back there to attend those meetings. The church looked beautiful.

I am currently in Oklahoma City making schedule arrangements for our next church projects this Winter and Spring/Summer 2010. I have had meetings in Texas, Kansas, Illinois, and I leave tomorrow for Colorado. I will leave Friday after Thanksgiving for Liberal, Kansas to relocate the roof drains on their new church complex. Then on to Illinois to help with a room addition, hoping to be complete by Christmas.
